

## Grant Funding!

- The city applied for and received a planning grant from the **Capital Matrix Foundation** in the amount of \$7,300
- The city applied for and received a planning grant from **COMPASS** as part of the **Communities In Motion** Grant in the amount of \$16,000
- **JUB Engineers Inc** will continue to work with Kuna to pursue the goals from the downtown stakeholders meeting of establishing a strategic plan for revitalization and funding. Their services will be funded by the grants received and match from the city.
- The city applied for and received a **Marketing for Growth** grant from **Idaho Power** in the amount of \$3,000 for new marketing materials to help promote Kuna's Economic Development and Tourism.

## Next Steps...

- Define a scope of work with the new planning grants with JUB Engineers Inc. The results will put the priorities in place to pursue further funding and projects.
- Schedule a stakeholders meeting for input and direction.
