## PREPARING FOR UPCOMING WINTER

The following items are general and preventative suggestions that are in need of attention to better assist the snow removal process:

When shoveling snow, be sure to:

- **Shovel often.** It is important to clear driveways and sidewalks as frequently as the snow falls. This will help cars get out of driveways and kids walk to their bus stops
- **Shovel snow to yards and common areas- NOT in the road.** This will prevent excess snow on sidewalks and roads and will allow better access to mailboxes- **DO NOT** pile snow on storm drains!
- **Shovel sidewalks.** You are responsible for clearing your sidewalk- property line to property line

Storm Drains:

- Know their locations!
- Do not park over or near storm drains
- Keep them clear of snow and ice to avoid flooding

Other things to keep in mind:

- Try to park vehicles in driveways and garages. This will help snow plows get around and prevent cars on the street from getting plowed in
- Be aware of the state of your mailboxes- make sure they will be accessible
- **BE A HELPFUL NEIGHBOR WHEN NEEDED**
