



Welcome & Opening Comments from Mayor Stear

Council President Abel welcomed everyone to the meeting.

1. Consideration to approve Mayors Youth Council Minutes

Council Member DeHaven moved to approve the Youth Council Minutes from November 9, 2017. Seconded by Council Member Rousseau. Motion carried 4-0.

2. Update on promotional ideas and activities/fundraisers - Youth Council Members

Council President Abel shared the school librarian did not know at that time if the library was available.

Council Member DeHaven volunteered to speak with administration.
