

**1. Consideration to approve Mayors Youth Council Minutes**

- a. Approve Regular Mayors Youth Council Minutes, January 11, 2018**

**Youth Council Vice President DeHaven moved to approve January 11, 2018 minutes. Seconded by Youth Council Member Hudon. Motion carried 4-0.**

**2. Discuss Recreational Survey Results – Bobby Withrow, Parks Director**

Parks and Recreation Department Jake Lorentz presented the results from a recreation survey of 118 people from November into December 2017. The results for Spikeball were close but were against adding Spikeball by 5%. The results for adding volleyball were very strongly in favor of adding it. Volleyball resulted with 67% being in favor. With these results the City is looking to proceed with both options for additions to the City's amenities.

**3. Discuss questions and suggestions for the high school security guard and administrator – Youth Council Members**

Youth Council President Abel spoke with the security guard and was informed that he would need to speak to building administration to set up a meeting. He stated he had not been able to get a meeting with Mr. Graves or Mr. Beams yet. He would continue to try to meet with them to set up a meeting.

4. Discuss possible action regarding Youth Council Members not attending regular meetings – Youth Council Members

Mayor Stear advised the Youth Council to wait until the following meeting to address this item.

5. Mayor/Youth Council/Staff Announcements

Parks Director Bobby Withrow advised that parks staff would present fundraiser ideas in a future meeting.

Mayor Stear advised that the Youth Council would need to determine where to spend the money prior to planning a fund raiser.

Youth Council Member Hudon asked if there was a service project his group from school could help with such as helping to clean up the BLM ground that people use for shooting.

Mr. Withrow advised that they could possibly volunteer to help with the cleanup project that Reed Elementary School does, or possibly organize a creek cleanup while there was no water in the creek.

Youth Council Member Young stated she had heard complaints about the library being too small and asked if there was a plan for expansion.

Mayor Stear advised that the library wanted to expand but they did not get the bond to pass. The Youth Council could possibly help with a presentation for a future bond.
