#### **2. Discussion and update on Community Open House and Artist Call – Chris Engels, City Clerk**

The Commission needed to do a better job promoting. They asked if it was OK for everyone to share and cross post activities.


They needed to find out how much it would cost to advertise in the Kuna Melba News and advertise for free on all community calendars.
