Commissioner Tom Matus Third item of business is Consideration for approval of artwork by Mary Gardiner to review her submittal and artwork, I'll turn it over to Leah.

Arts and History Center Curator Leah Torres Yeah. So we got another application that we received to display art at the arts and History Center. And I'd like to preface this with at the current moment, you know, at the last meeting we approved Tisha Johnson's artwork for display for the August rotation to November and in that motion we also or in the motion that passed it was also said that if she agrees to do so, she would show the rest of her artwork starting November through the rest of the year. She agreed to do that. So we have essentially the rest of the year covered with art by Tisha Johnson. So next quarter we'll be showing Tisha's work, as well. And so considering that when I received Mary Gardiner's application, I figured we can have a head start on next year's rotation for art so we can get that set up already. I put it for this quarter in particular, which is from July 23rd to October 3rd because with the documents that she submitted that would be the quarter that would work for her to show her artwork because she's showing in different places from March to May. So that rules out the first two quarters and then in October she's showing. But I am... I figured since the rotation goes to the beginning of October if she needs to, you know, if it's if she's showing her artwork in the middle of that October next year, then it would still work. That quarter would work for her. So that's why I put her in for the third quarter of next year. Seems kind of far away, but it's good to kind of plan these things already rather than, You know, getting an application a month or so before and then trying to get them in. So that's why I have her for this third quarter of next year.

Commissioner Tom Matus I like that proposal as well as scheduling, so that's that sounds good.

Arts and History Center Curator Leah Torres Awesome, And so for her application, she submitted 17 artworks...She submitted 17 artworks and...I'm sorry I lost my train of thought. Oh it an for an exhibit called the "Artist Lens" I believe. We like to call it in here I also put a diagram of the center because I know that was discussed last time because it was kind of hard to get an idea of what the center looked like or the space looked like, so I put in there in the packet a diagram of the center so we can see what we're working with and my thoughts are, If the Commission agrees, you know we have the main room, the side room, and the hallway that all have hanging rails, and considering that the space that was initially going to be considered the art gallery is not opened and we don't have a set date for when that will be completed, we can use the space in a flexible way. So for her 17 works I was considering, if you all agree, we can show her pieces in the main room and the side room and the history exhibit can be held in the hallway, sort of the reverse of what is shown in the in the center at the moment. So all of her 17 pieces would fit in that side room in the main room, and then we can have a history exhibit in the hallway. If you're looking at the diagram, her pieces would fit in those two rooms, and then we could still have history exhibit in the hallway off to the side. So again we will have art and history exhibits just formulated in a different way in the space.

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Commissioner Tom Matus Great, thank you for that. That sounds good. Especially after we had that... The type of a discussion last time, so this fits. And I'm glad to see you, you know, have another submission, right? And this should help them as well. What's your plans on when they bring the artwork in? Just to fit it where we can put it or what's your thoughts?

Arts and History Center Curator Leah Torres So that's what I was working on earlier today, seeing different ways that you know we can fit the pieces. I mean they're I tried out different ways of setting the pieces up I think again. You know, if Mary agrees, if we choose her, what have you? There's a lot of ways that the piece could be set up, but I did think of certain layouts that would look best with the flow of the pieces. So I have an idea of where pieces could go, but of course we can, you know, take into consideration anything Mary has to say about that. But what I do know is that they all fit there and they will fit in that space. Where they're set to be could change, but yeah, I know for sure that they'll fit in those spaces that are allotted for it.

So that's what the Arts and History Center booth is. There will also be an information table. Where in the process of finalizing and making pamphlets for the center posters for advertising the centers art display space for next year and we'll have the applications and packet there for people to take and a pamphlet on the current history exhibit at the center as well. 




Artist: Laurie Bremer

A wife, mother of five, and grandmother to many, Laurie carries a psychology degree and currently works at a center for developmentally-delayed awesome adults in Meridian.







