D. Discuss Kuna Arts Commission's 2025 Budget

Chairwoman DebAnn Rippy Okay, then it looks like we're at a point where we will discuss the Kuna Arts Commission budget.

Arts and History Center Curator Leah Torres Yeah.

Chairwoman DebAnn Rippy *[inaudible]* to the City.

Arts and History Center Curator Leah Torres Yeah, so I took, well I put this item in here because the Commission has mentioned, you know, wanting to discuss budget. It's on here not as an action item just in case we don't want to have any certain sort of decisions made. This is so to have a discussion primarily like seeing if you want to allot a certain amount of money towards you know a certain...

Chairwoman DebAnn Rippy Project or program or something.

Arts and History Center Curator Leah Torres Project, yeah things like. So that's kind of what this space is.

Deputy City Clerk Garrett Michaelson The staff is also wondering, as far as your budget, are you wanting to allocate a specific... we can't determine that tonight because it's a non-action item, but we can certainly look into it. Are you wanting to allocate funds for the City to purchase like, art supplies to have

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at the Art and History Center for people to come to the Art and History Center and participate in art, or the production of art, making art, at the Center.

Chairwoman DebAnn Rippy I would think that that could possibly be some of what we would consider where we look at our map of that participation piece so that could possibly be something. It depends I suppose on what it is that we would choose to say could these be priority kinds of items so that we can know whether or not there's going to be some budget for that. So, I don't know if it's appropriate at this point to start to discuss as I look at the planning template. It looks like, Leah, you've done a great job of figuring out the history. Looks like we have fine and traditional arts for display all the way through really pretty complete. So, I'm thinking that we may want to look at trying to focus on the performing arts what could or should be done and maybe some participation pieces. And so that's where I would anticipate might need some budget. So, what would be helpful at this point, if it's just open for discussion? Should we just throw out some ideas about what could happen?

Deputy City Clerk Garrett Michaelson I think that would be helpful for the City to sort of start looking at how those funds could be expended. And so that we could potentially get back to you with...

Chairwoman DebAnn Rippy Kind of rough estimate or something.

Deputy City Clerk Garrett Michaelson Yeah.

Chairwoman DebAnn Rippy Yeah. Okay.

Deputy City Clerk Garrett Michaelson Yeah, start looking into stuff. Like I said we can't make any determination tonight, but we can certainly start looking into that and then bring it forward at a following Art Commission meeting with an action item next to it.

Chairwoman DebAnn Rippy Okay, and we might be able to kick around some ideas and then maybe by the next meeting we could prioritize and then you might be able to have a feel for dollars. Some of the things that I had considered would be, for participation, it might be like to have someone who would do a presentation of Kuna history, and it could be like slideshow. It could be somebody just sitting and talking, like Story Night in Boise and they talk about their experiences from the past. Something that we have that vocal history captured and that people could sit and actually hear and maybe even interact. That could be a possibility. I'm thinking a demonstration of some of those fine arts. It could be sculpting, woodworking, quilting. We have the leather working. If there are artists in the community who might be willing to either volunteer, or for a fee, be able to come in and demonstrate. I don't know if that could work into actually somebody doing it but at the very least to have those demonstrations of those traditional and non-traditional arts would be kind of a fun thing to have. Workshops for the performing arts for, for singing, for dance, in the theater area. I'm thinking readers theater, theater games, improv instruction, any and or all of those could be participatory.

The other things I was thinking, or I had kind of kicked around if we're looking at trying to not just do it in the Center but from the Center be able to use some other City space, perhaps in combination with a July 4th celebration or Kuna Days celebration. Maybe in the park we would have music. And it could be that that maybe there's a musician or a small group, or again musical artists that we have in our community that could be a part of that celebration. We do have dance classes so I know that we have people, kids that do dance and so that could be a possibility. I would love to see us do some kind of theater and if we're in the park I think of Neil Simon's *'Barefoot in the Park'* would be a great one to do for the community. So those things might be something that we could look at, prioritize, and say yes, no,

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or this might be something we do this year or wait until next year, these are the ones we can or can't do. Sidewalk chalk contest would be a fun thing to do. If we get to the point and I know this would be quite a bit of work but if we got to the point where we had playwrights and then they came, and we did...read their original plays. That would be a great performance and not too costly because you wouldn't have to do a whole production. So those are just some of the ideas that I thought maybe the budget would be able to handle. And perhaps even with some of those if we decide these are the things we want to do what we could do is even create a grant process. So, the City 's not dependent on putting this all together but rather we open it up as a grant and then whoever applies and is accepted as the grantee, then becomes the manager and responsible for getting it done. So those were some of the ideas that I had concerning the budget.

Arts and History Center Curator Leah Torres Great, yeah, these, it's awesome to hear ideas for what we want to put in the budget towards like just discussing this. It's great to hear those ideas. Yeah it is good.

Chairwoman DebAnn Rippy Okay anything else that we should look at in terms of budget or any information.

Deputy City Clerk Garrett Michaelson I think that is quite helpful for us to start looking at and then sort of seeing what's available and possible within the Arts Commission budget. Did you have anything additional, Leah, that you wanted to mention regarding that?

Arts and History Center Curator Leah Torres No, I think, I liked hearing about sort of events that you want to do. I think it's good to, you know, see how much money we can, you know, put towards that. Also, it's not, you know, as big of a thing as sort of these events but maybe you know allocating some money towards facilities at the Center with you know if we need things at the Center for an exhibit or for an artist or something you know just having money allotted towards that. And maybe having money allotted towards openings as well so we can sort of have, you know, every time we have like any, a new opening of an exhibit or an artist we could have a little you know maybe a table of refreshments or something you know.

Chairwoman DebAnn Rippy And come and meet the artist and interact and get people through the door.

Arts and History Center Curator Leah Torres Yeah so that was a couple things I was thinking along with sort of events but it's, you know, I'm glad to hear some event ideas that you're kind of thinking of as well.

Chairwoman DebAnn Rippy And I'm thinking too there's probably things that we don't even know yet that you need to have down there that we haven't been able to get. So, I'm sure those things will come up as well for equipment or whatever you would call it. Okay.

Deputy City Clerk Garrett Michaelson Is, from the historical side is there anything as far as like... That you would potentially want the City to look into for. Like historical presentations, Dave, or... Is there something we can do or the City can look into regarding...on that end.

Vice Chair Dave Lyon One thing I had in mind is, in regard to history, is the history of Kuna schools. And Mister Doug Rotan, has made one in the past and it would be great I think to have him if he's available to do something like that. And he would need some sort of projector probably. Which I don't know the City probably has something like that? But that's one idea that I had in history presentation.

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Deputy City Clerk Garrett Michaelson Thank you.

Chairwoman DebAnn Rippy Okay, is there any anything else we need to discuss for budget? So we will probably be discussing the next meeting or a future meeting.

Deputy City Clerk Garrett Michaelson You will likely see that at the next meeting or the following meeting. We'll try to move forward as with like next meeting. There may need to be some stuff worked out and if that's the case it would be the following meeting, but we will push for next meeting.

Arts and History Center Curator Leah Torres Or if you're, yeah. For a new position or have you. Also, there are stated in the bylaws that there are one-year terms, the max of two years, two consecutive terms in the same position as well, or in a single office, just so you're aware of that.

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Chairwoman DebAnn Rippy Okay, and will you help us know when and where we are in that progression at some point.

Arts and History Center Curator Leah Torres Yeah, yeah, yeah, for sure.

Chairwoman DebAnn Rippy For sure that 'd be great Okay. Any questions? Dave, you have anything on that?

I have in here sort of that planning template that we use so we know and the rotation display that we have for history on here, just so Commissioners are aware of that. So we have a history display for every quarter. And now since we voted on those artist applications we also have an artist for every quarter as well, as long as they accept of course but we have that planned. Yeah so we have those. You can see sort of the first quarter we have a 'Pictures of Home' display for history and then we'll have Ying Peng's artwork. We have a display on the Community Improvement Club for the second quarter. And we have a sort of agricultural display planned for the third. And Kuna Beginnings which is a sort of rerun of an exhibit we did this year but, considering it distinctly related to Kuna history, we decided we'd do it again. Because that's a, you know, one that people would like to see again. Again, yeah, there's no participation events but we have each quarter planned. So now we can you know perhaps focus on participation events like we've discussed a little bit earlier. But yeah so I wanted to include that we do have the... I'm going to be helping and participating in the Candy Canes with the Mayor event that's going to be held here in the Council Chambers on December 19th. I'll be doing again sort of similar to the Art Attack Event, a little stamp process where I'll be making little cards with the kids that stop by. So that's an event we're doing for this December as a Center.

Chairwoman DebAnn Rippy Okay.

Arts and History Center Curator Leah Torres But yeah so those are just some updates about what's happened. And we had a homeschool group come at the end of November, to stop by and looked at the exhibits that we had and things like that. So yeah just some updates on the Center.

Chairwoman DebAnn Rippy Thank you. And is this something that you, you do want us to try to fill in, or do you feel comfortable where you are right now? Do we want to at some point say these are the participation things? I see we don't have any performance arts represented yet, so do we want to try to prioritize that? What's your feeling, what's the City direction on that?

Arts and History Center Curator Leah Torres Well so that's where sort of the Commission will come in. It's like, you know, what do you guys want to prioritize, what do you want to bring to the Center? If we want, you know, if the Commission wants to focus on bringing performance arts we could, you know, the Commission can do that sort of you know that's kind of where you all would step in and you know bring those ideas and stuff.

Arts and History Center Curator Leah Torres Yeah, yeah.

Chairwoman DebAnn Rippy And I also know that you did printmaking with the Art Attack in September. So, that was a participation event. Do you anticipate that will be possible in September next year?

Arts and History Center Curator Leah Torres I do believe they plan on doing Art Attack again so that would also be sort of an event that maybe, you know, when we're looking at the budget that the Arts Commission have put you know more money towards or you know we can do a different event and the Arts Commission can you know fund that event or something. You know what I mean. So yeah, I think I do believe that they plan on doing that event again.

Arts and History Center Curator Leah Torres Yeah.


