

City of Kuna PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE A Hearing to Consider Adopting Ordinance No. 2019-20 & Resolution No. R46-2019

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Kuna City Council will hold a public hearing to take public testimony concerning a proposed ordinance regarding temporary mobile vendor permits and a resolution amending and reforming temporary mobile vendor fees set in Resolution No. R66-2014.

Ordinance No. 2019-20 will amend Kuna City Code Title 3, Chapter 9 titled <u>Temporary Mobile Vendor's Permit</u> to redefine temporary, provide more license duration options, update application and license information, clarify vendor restrictions, and provide an effective date.

Resolution No. R46-2019 will amend and reform temporary mobile vendor permit fees set in Resolution No. R66-2014 to increase the thirty (30) day permit fee and establish one hundred eighty (180) day permit and three hundred sixty (360) day permit fees to cover administrative costs.

The public hearing will be held **Tuesday**, **July 2**, **2019** at **6:00 p.m**. or as soon as can be heard, in the Council Chambers, Kuna City Hall, 751 W. 4th Street, Kuna, ID 83634.

The public is invited to provide written or oral testimony for Council's consideration. Written testimony (letters) must be submitted to the Kuna City Clerk by **Thursday**, **June 27**, **2019** at 5:00 p.m. to be included in the Council packets for review. Written testimony and documents may be dropped off at City Hall or mailed to P.O. Box 13, Kuna, ID 83634.

All persons wishing to testify must state their name and residential address. No person shall speak until recognized by the Mayor. A three (3) minute time limit will be placed on all testimonies.

Please do not contact anyone who would be involved in the decision-making process, which would include City Council Members or the Mayor, as such private conversations would be considered ex parte (one sided) and could jeopardize the public hearing process.
